MBA (Shipping & Logistics) ADMISSION, 2021-2022

Notification

Eligibility Criteria:

The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (45% marks in case of SC/ST/SEBC/EWS Category candidates), awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an act of the Central or State legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a university as per the UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India. (Formerly Ministry of Human Resource Development).

Candidates appearing for the final year of bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results can also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, only if he/she submits a certificate from the Principal/Registrar of his/her College/Institute within one month of commencement of classes stating that the candidate has completed all the requirements for obtaining the bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification on the date of the issue of the certificate.

Selection Process:

The total number of seats for MBA (Shipping & Logistics) is 60. 50% of the seats i.e. 30 seats will be filled from the state quota, administered by Admission Committee for Professional Courses (ACPC) and remaining 50% seats will be from All India seats. The selection process has been described below:

➤ **State Quota Seats (30 Seats)**

For admission under the State quota seats, a candidate has to apply at Admission Committee for Professional Courses (ACPC) website (<http://www.jacpcldce.ac.in/>) and follow the instructions therein. The Admission Committee for Professional Courses (ACPC) shall prepare a merit list, out of the students who have applied for the course. Candidates are to follow the document and fee submission deadlines as specified by the ACPC.

➤ **All India Seats (30 Seats)**

Students seeking admission for the program can apply online on the University website www.gmu.edu.in under the admissions section and fill the requisite application forms. The application forms and the fee payment links will be available from 15th April 2021, 10:00 AM onwards. **Last date of submission of application forms is 07th June 2021, 5:00 PM.**

Gujarat Maritime University will conduct its own Admission Test for selecting students for this program and the selection of the students will be done based on the criteria mentioned below:

Criterion	Weights
Proctored Online MCQ test	70%
Personal Interview	30%

Guidelines for Proctored Online MCQ Test

The Admission Test will include 70 Multiple Type questions (MCQ) each question carrying one mark. It shall be of 60 minutes duration. There will not be any negative marks for wrong answers. The question paper will be based on Quantitative aptitude, Logical Reasoning, Data Interpretation, Verbal Ability & Comprehension. The test will be conducted on 13th June 2021 at 11:00 AM.

Computer / Laptop / Tablet or Mobile with video and audio facility with good internet connectivity is required to appear for the proctored online test.

All the guidelines with respect to the proctored online test will be provided in Mock / Demo test dated for 11th June, 2021.

Guidelines for Personal Interview

Personal interview will be taken online for the students on 14th and 15th June 2021. The details of the same will be sent to each candidate separately, by E-mail.
