Admission Notification

Applications are invited for admission to One Year Post Graduate Diploma in Maritime Law Programme and Post-Graduate Diploma in International Trade Law Programme batch 2021-2022.

Eligibility Criteria:

The candidates must hold a Graduate Degree in any discipline from a recognized University with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA and 45% marks or equivalent CGPA in case of SC/ST category candidates.

The holders of the 'Certificate of Competency as Master of Foreign Going Ship' are also eligible to the programme, subject to the production of 'Certificate of Equivalency' issued by a University competent to issue 'Certificate of Equivalency'.

Application Fee:

The application fee is Rs. 4,000/- for General Category and Rs. 2,000/- for SC, ST, OBC and Gujarat Domicile (non-refundable).

Selection Process:

The admission to the diploma will be based on the merit secured in the Personal Interview and the evaluation of the Statement of Purpose (SOP). The weightage assigned to the admission criterion is as follows:

Criterion	weightage
Personal Interview	70%
Evaluation of Statement of Purpose	30%

Guidelines for Personal Interview:

The online personal interviews will be held **9th - 10th July 2021**. The details of the same will be sent to each applicant separately by E-mail and will also be published on the University website.

Guidelines for Statement of Purpose:

The applicants are required to submit a Statement of Purpose along with the application form. The length of the Statement of Purpose may be 300-500 words. It should give educational and professional background of the applicant. It should also specify why the applicant should be considered for the Diploma and how it will be useful for career advancement.
