Prof. Mukesh Parikh is a trainer and consultant for Global Maritime, Logistics and Supply chain Industry with over 40 years' hands-on Industry experience. The first half of his career was in Commercial Shipping, while the second half was in Ports, Terminals and Logistics Industry. With Post Graduation in Business Management from XLRI, Jamshedpur (1975-77 batch); he started his Maritime Industry career with The Shipping Corporation of India Limited (SCI). During his career with the SCI, he was trained as an Instructor by UNCTAD. As a trained instructor, he was actively involved in Training through an UNCTAD+UNDP project "TRAINMAR". Under the TRAINMAR project, he organized several training programs for shipping executives in India, Indian Sub-Continent, Asia and Middle East. He was deputed by The SCI to The Norwegian Shipping Academy Oslo, Norway where he attended one year "Professional Shipping" program securing the First Rank among all participants from 14 different countries.

He worked for a number of shipping companies in Asia and the Middle East.
