Gujarat Maritime University invites online applications from eligible candidates for admission to its following programmes.

- 1. MBA in Shipping and Logistics and Port Management (Batch 2025 27).
- One-year LL.M. degree programme in Maritime Law and International Trade Law (Batch 2025 - 26).
- Executive Diploma Programme (EDP) in Maritime Law, International Trade Law and Shipping & Logistics (Batch 2025 - 26).

1. MBA Programme

The two-year MBA Programme, offered through the School of Maritime Management, Gujarat Maritime University is being offered with two specializations namely Shipping and Logistics and Port Management.

The MBA – Shipping & Logistics programme was conceptualized and designed by the Copenhagen Business School, Denmark in lines with its **BLUE MBA** programme.

1.1. Eligibility

The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized University with at least 50% marks for General Category or equivalent CGPA (45% marks in case of SC/ST/SEBC/EWS category candidates).

The holders of the 'Certificate of Equivalency' issued by Association of Indian Universities or any other competent institution are also eligible to the programme.

Candidates appearing for the final year of bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results may also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, subject to completion of all the requirements and fulfillment of eligibility criteria in due course of time.

1.3. Selection Process

The selection process of the programme is through the following two methods:

1.3.1. All India Seats (60 Seats)

The candidates seeking admission under this category may submit the online application by visiting the University website (https://gmu.edu.in/)

The selection process will be on the basis of performance of the candidate in the National Level Online Remotely Proctored Entrance Test and Personal Interview conducted by the University. The remotely proctored online entrance test will include 70 Objective Type Questions (MCQs) each question carrying one mark. The duration of the test will be 90 minutes. There will not be any negative marking for wrong answers. The question paper will be based on Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, Data Interpretation, Verbal Ability & Comprehension

The weightage of the selection process will be as follows:

Personal Interview	30%

Candidates securing more than 50% marks in the Online Remotely Proctored Entrance Test will be called for the Personal Interview at first instance. If sufficient candidates are not found eligible, the University may call the remaining candidates for the personal Interview as well. The Personal Interview credentials will be sent to the eligible candidates separately by E-mail.

However, the candidates having a valid CMAT/CAT/MAT score for the corresponding year, are not required to participate in the University Admission selection process.

As per the Notification issued by Education Department dated 24th June, 2020 the candidate with the CMAT score will be given the preference while preparing merit list followed by CAT, MAT and GMU Entrance.

1.3.2. State Quota Seats (60 Seats)

For admission under the State quota seats a candidate must apply through the Admission Committee for Professional Courses (ACPC) website (http://www.jacpcldce.ac.in/), and follow the instructions provided therein and select "Gujarat Maritime University" as the first preference for admission.

2. LL.M. Programme

The one-year LL.M. degree Programme is being offered through the Centre for Post Graduate Legal Studies, Gujarat Maritime University as per UGC Guidelines for Introduction of one-year LL.M degree Programme, 2012. The LL.M Programme is being offered with two specializations namely Maritime Law and International Trade Law.

2.1. Eligibility

The candidate must hold an LLB/Equivalent Degree in law from a recognized University with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade in cases of general category/OBC/PWD/NRI/PIO/OCI and 45% marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category.

Candidates appearing for the final year qualifying examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results may also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, subject to completion of all the requirements and fulfillment of eligibility criteria in due course of time.

2.3 Selection Process

The selection for the programme will be based on a National Level Online Remotely Proctored entrance test followed by a Personal Interview of the candidates. The weightage of the selection process will be as follows:

In case, if any seat remains vacant after the conclusion of the GMU LL.M. admission process, the same will be filled on the basis of merit secured by the candidates in Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) for the corresponding year. CLAT aspirants are also required to make an application for admission by following the aforementioned process and select CLAT as the mode of admission.

2.3.1. Entrance Test

The remotely proctored online entrance test will include 70 Objective Type Questions (MCQs) each question carrying one mark. The duration of the test will be 60 minutes. There will not be any negative marking for wrong answers. The question paper will be based on the core subjects of the undergraduate integrated LLB or LLB Programme and will include Constitutional Law, Jurisprudence, Administrative Law, Law of Contract, Torts, Criminal Law and Public International Law. It will also include questions from research & teaching aptitude, and current affairs.

2.3.2. Personal Interview

Candidates securing more than 50% marks in the Online Remotely Proctored Entrance Test will be called for the Personal Interview at first instance. If sufficient candidates are not found eligible, the University may call the remaining candidates for the personal Interview as well. The Personal Interview credentials will be sent to the eligible candidates separately by E-mail.

3. Executive Diploma Programme (EDP)

The one-year EDP Programme, offered through the School of Maritime Law and Policy is being offered with two specializations namely Maritime Law and International Lade Law and School of Maritime Management is being offered with one specialization namely Shipping and Logistics.

3.1. Eligibility

The candidates must hold a three-year bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any discipline recognized by University as eligibility for Postgraduate studies with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA and 45% marks or equivalent CGPA in case of SC/ST category candidates and a minimum of one year of work experience.

The holders of the 'Certificate of Equivalency' issued by Association of Indian Universities or any other competent institution are also eligible to the programme.

3.3. Selection Process

The admission to the diploma will be based on the merit secured in the Personal Interview and the evaluation of the Statement of Purpose (SOP). The weightage assigned to the admission criterion is as follows:

3.3.1. Personal Interview

The online personal interviews' credentials will be sent to each applicant separately by E-mail.

3.3.2. Statement of Purpose

The applicants are required to submit a Statement of Purpose via email to admissions@gmu.edu.in, after submitting the application form through the University website by or before the deadline. The length of the Statement of Purpose may be 300-500 words. It should give the educational and professional background of the applicant. It should also specify why the applicant should be considered for the diploma and how it will be useful for his/her career advancement.
