About GMB

GUJARAT MARITIME BOARD

Gujarat Maritime Board (GMB) is a statutory body of the Government of Gujarat, established in 1982 under the Gujarat Maritime Board Act, 1981. GMB is vested with the authority to develop, manage, control, and administer the non-major ports in the State of Gujarat. Over the years, GMB has established itself as a maritime leader in port development, port privatisation, and wide range of cargo handling, leveraging Gujarat's strategic location as a natural gateway to the landlocked northern and central hinterland comprising of West, North and Central India. Gujarat has the longest coastline in India constituting 48 non-major ports, spanning approximately 2,340 km, and accounts for nearly 30% of the country's cargo traffic and 66% of national non-major port traffic. As of 2024-25, the non-major ports under GMB has a combined handling capacity of about 598 MMTPA, with actual cargo traffic of approximately 488 MMTPA.

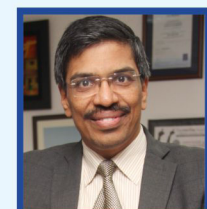

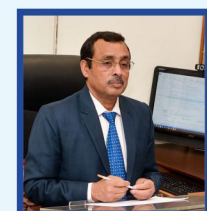

MBA Maritime Management Programme

The two-year MBA Programme, offered through the School of Maritime Management, Gujarat Maritime University was conceptualized and designed by the Copenhagen Business School, Denmark in lines with its BLUE MBA programme. The MBA Programme is being offered with two specializations namely Shipping & Logistics and Port Management.

Eligibility

The candidate must hold a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized University with at least 50% marks for General Category or equivalent CGPA (45% marks in case of SC/ST/SEBC/EWS category candidates). The holders of the 'Certificate of Equivalency' issued by Association of Indian Universities or any other competent institution are also eligible to the programme.

Candidates appearing for the final year of bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results may also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, subject to completion of all the requirements and fulfillment of eligibility criteria in due course of time.

* Subject to the fee structure that may be determined by the Fee Regulatory Committee (Technical) constituted under section 9 (1) of the Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007, for the University, any amount paid in excess to the fee structure finally determined by Fee Regulatory Committee (Technical) shall be refunded to the students. Similarly, any amount due to the University as fee structure in excess of what has been paid shall have to be deposited to the University by the students, if applicable.

LL.M. Programme

The one-year LL.M. degree Programme offered through the School of Maritime Law, Policy & Administration, Gujarat Maritime University as per UGC Guidelines for Introduction of one-year LL.M degree Programme, 2012. The LL.M Programme is being offered with two specializations namely Maritime Law and International Trade Law.

Eligibility

The candidate must hold an LLB/Equivalent Degree in law from a recognized University with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade in cases of general category/OBC/PWD/NRI/PIO/OCI and 45% marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category. Candidates appearing for the final year qualifying examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results may also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally, subject to completion of all the requirements and fulfillment of eligibility criteria in due course of time.

- Candidates who have completed Master's degree programme corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.
